From the Word - “Holy, Spirit, Please Turn on the Light” - 1 Corinthians 2:14

As Pastor Steve said Sunday, we can't really understand the Bible apart from the ministry of the Holy Spirit, as Paul makes evident in this verse. We discover this by asking several questions:

Who is the “natural person”? This is the unbeliever who lives in his own strength.

What are “the things of the Spirit of God”? This is the truth revealed in the Bible, centered on the message of the cross. It is offensive to our proud, self-righteous hearts.

What does “he is not able to understand them” mean? People don't “get” the message of the Bible. They may understand the words or even be able to explain them, but they don't accept them.

What does “they are spiritually discerned” mean? To discern is to assign proper worth. The unbeliever does not make a right appraisal of the gospel, but values many other things more.

Isn't this text a description of all of us? Yes, this is who we are by nature, and change comes only through the new birth of the Holy Spirit.

How should I respond to this text if I'm a Christian? With praise! With humility! With the understanding that you still need the ministry of the Holy Spirit to treasure the things of God.

How should I respond to this text if I'm not yet a Christian? Repent and believe!
